Installing a solar street light is a small step towards a cleaner environment as most of the electricity is obtained from non-renewable and polluting fossil fuels.



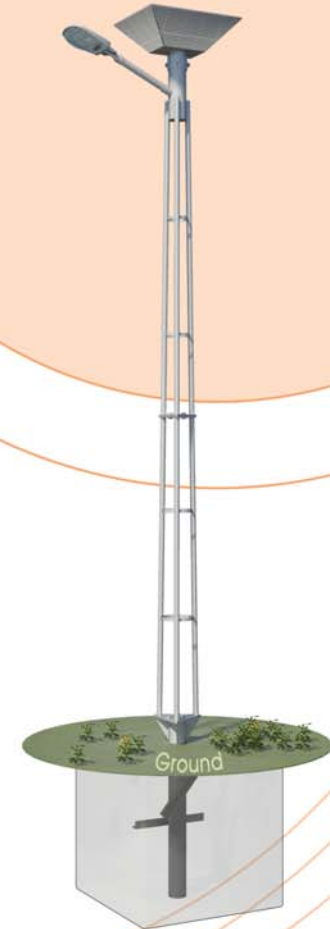

Automatic operation from dusk to dawn. (Check specifications)\*

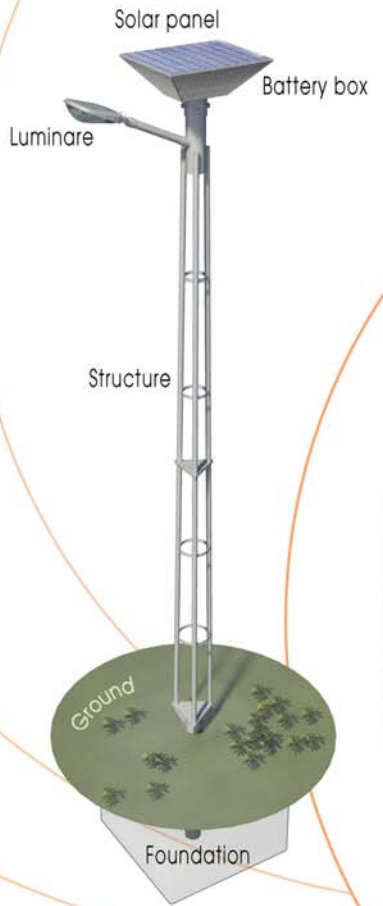


**STRUCTURE:**
